With the culmination of the April 2009 Philippine Ministry Leaders Summit, Full Gospel Assemblies – Philippines has been birthed as an alliance of Full Gospel churches.

Since 2006, mission activities from the USA to the Philippines have increased to include annual youth convention leadership, ministers, pastors and family conferences, and church building.

Today the vision has expanded to bring together church fellowships and congregations throughout the country that Full Gospel Assemblies has had opportunity to join in ministry with. Church leadership, pastors, and parishioners of the countries of Sao Tome, Angola, DR Congo, Gabon, Rep. of Congo, Zambia, Botswana, and Namibia and others are preparing to gather in Angola for the first Full Gospel Assemblies African convention. This convention is to be held in the city of Saurimo in the western plain land of the country.

Archbishop Antonio Kakoma of Zambia and Bishop Nhakatola of Angola are working together with Angolan President Santos in the preliminary efforts for this event expected to receive thousands seeking a special touch from God.

Fresh out of decades of civil war troubles, Angola has limited crops. Food is a necessity to have available for the sojourners to the convention. FGA leadership of Zambia are now preparing to truck in the food staple *mealmealie* to Saurimo ahead of this 3 day convention to be stored there. Mealmealie cost plus shipment and related convention costs are estimated to exceed \$5000.00. U.S. Missions has received \$2165.00 toward this mission! Angolan leadership is gathering donations of items such as sugar and spices and other available items on the local market. *All donations earmarked Angolan Mission will be dedicated to this ministry unto the Lord*.

Pastor Edward Popovich, Dir. of Min, and Pastor Simeon Strauser, will be leading the ministry team to this convention for evangelistic services and meetings with church and government leadership. As the love of Christ, and the encouragement of fellow laborers is taken with the desire to forge a foundation for African church growth, your prayers will hold them up before God.
