Dear Pastors & Ministers,

**Love as First Fruit**

In the process of seeking your Timothy, it is imperative that we proceed using the standards already provided to us in the word of God. In 1Timothy 1:5, Paul reminds Timothy that our goal is love and that love comes from a pure heart, good conscience, and a sincere faith. Paul was persuaded that the younger Timothy was capable of exhibiting these character traits for in 2Timothy 1:5 he writes, "I am reminded of your sincere faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and now, I am sure dwells in you as well."

This attribute is one that is not forged by the journals of psychology, our Bible Institutes or our Seminaries, but by the work of the Holy Spirit residing in us. Jesus did say *we would be known by our fruit*, and it is the fruit displayed consistently that we need to observe so we may choose in a Godly manner. Paul not only was convinced that Timothy was capable of exercising love in the congregation, but would be able to exhort others in a way that would be assertive yet infused with God's love. The balance of these two (assertion & love) do not seem to be the norm in our society today and may even be lacking in our churches, but it is the model demonstrated in the Bible. Let us keep in mind that this does not mean to compromise the word of God in any way, for our greatest command is to love God before anything else.

In 1Timothy 1:3, Paul urged Timothy to charge, command, and order others not to teach false doctrines, myths and endless genealogies. Our Timothys must be people that can command in a loving way, producing results that will bless those they are in charge of and bless themselves, as they see the growth obtained in the process.

The aim of our Timothys will be to arouse love in others coming from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith. Love will be bred love. As we seek our Timothys, let us be guided by God's word and not by mere human accolades or accomplishments obtained by individuals.
