Missionary Patti Petrone of Lexington, KY along with her ministry companion Jaime Rhodes are preparing for an 18-24 month mission to the country of Rwanda, commencing in September.

Patti writes, "Jaime and I are mostly known for our passion for Jesus Christ and how we need HIM every day, as we continue learning to live a laid down sacrificed life unto Him. We're two from Kentucky who have a desire to serve God wherever He may send us. We both started out Missionaries to Africa over the last 4 to 5 years - God put a burden in our hearts for the women and children of Kanombe, Rwanda. A few years ago, God began to show us the need for a transitioning home to women coming out of hopelessness and prostitution in the area. You see, they are perceived as nothing and left without any hope."

The ministry there in Rwanda is the first refuge and transitioning home in the community for women and is known as Life Center Ministries. It's where many women and young adults come to heal. It's where they learn to build trust, gain life skills, and get the life changing knowledge of how much Jesus loves them.

Missionary Petrone goes on to explain, "We are an Outreach Ministry – With provision for: Shelter, Food, Clothing, Healing, Bible Study, Life Groups, Job Training, Health and Hygiene Education, and Biblical Guidance and direction in counseling.
