Growing Timothys By Pastor Juan Feliciano

Strengthened In His Grace

In the second chapter of 2 Timothy, Paul exhorts his young protégé to be strengthened by the grace that in Christ Jesus (vs.1). Paul is quite aware that if Timothy is to be successful in his endeavor for the kingdom he has to rely on God's grace. Paul experimented firsthand the devastating effects of moving in the opposite of grace which is legalism for he witnessed how legalism tried in various occasions to trounce the work the Holy Spirit was doing in the believers through grace. We have a prime example of this in the book of Acts chapter 15 when after the new gentile believers had received Christ, were baptized in Christ and had received the baptism in the Holy Spirit the Jewish Christians were trying to convince them that they needed to follow the rules of circumcision in order to be saved. In other words, they were saying that work the Holy Spirit had done in them was not sufficient. We know that this situation was corrected through the Jerusalem Council that took place in chapter 15. However, this legalistic spirit is alive and well within our Pentecostal settings today and I am persuaded that many of us have been victims of this spirit and may have even fallen prey to it. In this month's editorial of Charisma Magazine entitled: "Fire in My Bones" by Lee Grady (I strongly recommend you subscribe to Charisma if you haven't) points out 8

devastating effects that legalism can have on the body of grace. These are: 1) Lack of true joy. Legalism kills true their hearts always overflow with praise and gratitude.

Christ if we are not watchful to be strengthened by His joy; when someone has an encounter with God's mercy Walking around as a sourpuss does not exhibit the true legalistic mindset finds it difficult to receive the grace to

Christian life. 2) No real victory over sin. A person with a legalistic mindset finds it difficult to receive the grace to overcome sinful habits. Relax and let the Spirit of Christ live His life in you! He wants to and will give you the victory to live a life pleasing unto Him. 3) Unhealthy performance orientation. Many Christians feel they must earn the love of God by reading the bible, praying and performing other religious tasks. Remember God loved us and Christ died for us while we were still sinners (Romans 5:8). Chill out, know he loves you and enjoy it! 4) A critical, unloving attitude towards others. People who can't understand grace have a difficult time extending it to others. When you understand how much mercy has been extended to you, it's easy to show mercy to others. We can rebuke and correct in a way that is becoming of one who knows they reached mercy. 5) Obsessive focus on outward standards of dress or behavior. We all know some, those that believe God demands strict conformity to dress codes. When you walk in grace, the Spirit will lead you to dress and act in a way that honors Him, but will not conform to man-made dress codes. 6) Bondage to religious traditions. This is what we saw in Acts chapter 15; they simple did not want to leave the religious traditions. God is unchangeable in His nature, but He does new things. The legalistic spirit will say, "This is the way we have always done it". 7) A sectarian attitude toward other Christians. Those that don't understand God's grace think they have a corner on the market, so to speak. They find it hard to embrace that God is moving in other denominations as well. Some churches may even think that they are the only ones going to heaven. We need to embrace the whole body of Christ. 8) No assurance of salvation. The reason for the doubt is due to the fact that they trust on their own obedience instead of Christ.

Our Timothy's must be strengthened by grace. They need to be steered away from the toxicity of legalism and enjoy His unmerited favor which is GRACE!
