The Bible Continues", in which Peter is shown speaking to the disciples within a setting that most likely took place sometime in Chapter 5 of the book of Acts in which he states that in the beginning they were a handful of believers, but now they are a number that can't be

counted. Peter is seen speaking with much encouragement because he has seen what God has done and is aware that he is not alone (he never was only that he felt that way) on this journey. The prophet Elijah in the Old Testament came to a point in his ministry in which he felt alone and the only one left fighting and God had to reveal Himself

in a way that would reassure him that he was not, that there were still 7,000 others that had not bowed down to Baal (1Kings 19). Paul exhorts Timothy to share in suffering as a good soldier of Christ Jesus (2Timothy 2:3) for the soldier has to give up of himself for he no longer belongs to himself, but is now under the direction and orders of his superiors. The soldier must live a life of discipline, must be loyal to his commanders and must be willing to lay down his life for the greater cause. Paul uses this analogy to stress that a soldier is part of an army, a greater body of alone.
