If we are not careful it can even take over our churches today, this was evident in Paul's day and as we know there is nothing new under the sun. We are not exempt from it today. Quarreling is just a spirit of pride under the guise of a spirited debate, it says, "I will show you just how right I am and how superior my view is than yours". We are called to love one another, to be tender-hearted with each other and not be people that thrive on forcing our pride on others.
