Philippines May 17-June 2

Pastor Marissa Strauser and Minister Cynthia Smith (of PA) will be leading a missions trip to the Philippines wherein they will preach and minister with FG congregations, outreaches and brethren, including the children and families within the FG Project1016 Child Sponsorship program. They will also be meeting and providing ministerial care to clergy and church workers under the Philippine Alliance of Full Gospel Churches.

Mexico June 6 -25

Pastors Regi and Narcedalia Licht, along with Pastor Mike Plautz and Sam Plautz (of WI) will be leading the FG mission to Monterrey, Mexico this June where evangelistic meetings and street ministry will be held alongside the FG congregation Divina Gracia, led by FG Pastor Luis and Irma Campos. They will be joined by Chairman Simeon Strauser the 20th through 23rd, for the receiving of Divina Gracia congregation into FGA and pastoral leadership meetings with prayerful consideration for plans of expansion of FG Assemblies into Mexico.

Puerto Rico September 18-25

Pastors Juan and Mayra Feliciano, FG East Spanish Regional Representation will lead the 2017 FG mission to Camuy, Puerto Rico where they will be joined by FG Council leadership including Chairman Simeon Strauser and Vice Chairman Pastor Edward Popovich. Their itinerary includes revival services welcoming Pastor Robert Irizarry and Dr. Maria A. Quintero as FG ordained eldership and recognizing the Iglesia Cristiana Transformados por la Cruz as a FG congregation.

Growing Timothys



It should come as no surprise to us in leadership that we are living in difficult times (2Timothy 3). In a recent visit to our local Christian bookstore my wife and I were approached by a sister who we know quite well because of her longevity of working at this business. After leading us in the direction of what we were looking for she began to speak to us of her concerns for the church fellowship in that it has been affected by what is currently taking place in our nation politically and morally. I could sense her concern stemmed from that which she has not seen the likes of anytime in the past and was not quite sure as to how this could be handled. In reading 2Timothy chapter 3 there are some key words that depict precisely what is taking place in America today and has the potential to affect the church body as well if we are not vigilant. These terms used in 2Timothy are: proud, arrogant, abusive, ungrateful, unappeasable, slanderous, brutal, reckless, and swollen with conceit and without self-control. This is pretty much our daily bread when we watch the news every evening unfortunately. Our concern in leadership is that these negative and sinful ways can have an appearance of godliness (vs. 5) although as of late, I have witnessed its full blatant force. We cannot be ignorant of the fact that Satan will try to creep in disguised as an angel of light. Our Timothy's must be taught in light of scripture to discern the times we are living in, a concern in Paul's time and more so in our era as the return of our Lord is drawing ever so closer. The admonition we are given in verse 5 is to avoid such people and rightfully so for we are quite aware that those who have fallen in like patterns of lifestyle are difficult to persuade. We know our prays are powerful to the bringing down of strongholds and that they can and will cause change, but as to trying to bring about change through a one on one contact it is best to avoid as we have been admonished. Keeping our eyes fixed on God and seeking the things above will have us walking over the current tendencies of our society today.

FGA is honored to announce that the creation of offices for Spanish Ministry representation has been in progress since the beginning of the year. The goal for 2017 will be to have FG representation lead dialogue and subsequent ministry into communities where Spanish is the first language with the purpose of expanding FGA church development and ministry training throughout the USA and abroad. The development coincides with this year's planned missions to Mexico and Puerto Rico.

For the eastern United States, Pastors Juan and Mayra Feliciano have been appointed as representatives. Pastors Juan and Myra lead Calvary's Love Church, a multi-cultural, bilingual congregation in Springfield MA.

Meanwhile, Pastors Regi and Narcedalia Licht are representing the western United States. Pastors Regi and Narcedalia pastor the Bluffview Center of Hope in Prairie du Sac Wisconsin, and are now leading the FGA expansion of ministry development into the country of Mexico.
